Can computers practice medicine? Utah contracted with a start-up, called Doctronic, to provide about 200 common medications through AI. In April, Utah’s Medical Board called for an immediate suspension of the program.

Lawmakers created today’s shortage of doctors through mind-numbing, bureaucratic, digital reporting mandates and now governments are desperately funding companies who claim they can solve the problem with AI.
