DPC Doctors are a Deal - Self-Pay Patient

Are you looking for an affordable clinic with short waits for care? Consider Direct Primary Care (DPC). These practices are cash-only. Patients pay monthly, quarterly or yearly. The prices vary, but many patients find them very affordable. Most have pricing for children, for adults, and for senior citizens. They don't take Medicare or any government program, but they do take any patient that pays cash, as long as they have room for new patients.

With fewer patients, DPC practices typically spend 30 – 60 minutes with patients. These doctors are independent, and every practice is different. If you want a doctor who works for you, and one you can often text, see on weekends, or request a house call, look for a Direct Primary Care doctor.
