Trump Administrations Demands Your Medical Records

The Trump administration's Consumer Product Safety Commission is demanding that hospitals turn over detailed identifiable medical records of patients seen in the emergency room. The administration claims the National Electronic Injury Surveillance System will bring tracking for product-related injuries into the 21st century. That's bogus. For \$15.9 million, the system will pull your data without your consent.

The administration says hospital refusal to share could lead to penalties for information blocking, but information blocking is blocking patients from getting their own data. Call the White House Switchboard and tell Trump to shut down the Injury Surveillance system. Call: 202-456-1111.
