How to Call the White House

I want to tell you about a way to contact the White House that you may not realize exists. Most people go online to complete and send a form. But there are two phone lines. One is a comment line, and the other is the White House Switchboard.

I once called the switchboard at 10:00 PM just to hear the voicemail recording. But the switchboard operator answered by saying "Hello, this is the White House. How can I help you?" I told her I was just checking the line to see that it worked and bid her good night.

If you have a message for the President, these are two more options: the comment line or the White House Switchboard. Just search online for White House Switchboard and you'll find both numbers. Call away!
